YOUNGSTOWN CITY LEADERS WILL CUT THE RIBBON FOR THE NEW FIRE STATION NO. 9 ON WEDNESDAY, MARCH 5, 2014 AT 9:00 A.M.

This new station is located next to Ipes Playground at 1624 E. Midlothian Boulevard.

New Station No. 9 was an investment by the City of approximately \$930,000 and is necessary due to the deteriorated structural condition of the Sheridan Road Station. Station No. 9 is an extremely modest design which features complementing long-term structural design and modern-day utility innovations to save energy. It is designed to house two fire trucks. However, only one truck will be staffed at all times. The second truck will be utilized as a reserve truck for use in the event of multiple alarms. Today, with only eight city fire stations, this new location will provide quicker response to its entire district, and with the location next to I-680, it is ideally located for city-wide response.
